

CPA Awards: Bursary and Scholarships

The Awards and Recognition Committee (ARC) will adhere to the following policies for a transparent process for the CPA Awards: Bursary and Scholarships:

1. CPA NWT/NU makes two categories of Awards:
 - a. The bursaries will generally support a member or student based on merit and financial need
 - b. The scholarships focus on academic achievement and are available to candidates pursuing the CPA designation.
2. All applicants must be:
 - a. a resident of NWT or NU for more than six months, based on the application deadline date, and
 - b. working or qualified to work in NWT or NU.
3. The ARC has the authority to change the criteria, application, and application process for Awards.
4. Annually, the ARC will establish the timeline for application submission and assessment.
5. The applicant will provide all the required information on the approved forms.
6. Candidates can self-nominate.
7. ARC may independently collect information from CPA Canada, the employer, social media or other areas to assess the information submitted that supports the candidate's application.
8. The ARC will select successful candidates for the bursary and scholarship awards. The decision of ARC is not subject to appeal.
9. The Awards will only be awarded if an eligible candidate meets or exceeds the required criteria.
10. The candidate, the ARC, and others must keep the application confidential.
11. All applicants applying for Awards will be informed of ARC's decision.
12. ARC can advertise and use images of award recipients in professional materials to support and elevate the CPA profession.

Establishing Bursaries or Scholarships

Based on the recommendations of ARC, the CPA NWT/NU Board may establish a bursary or scholarship to recognize special events or CPAs who have made a distinguished contribution to the accounting body. The Award should enhance the professional stature of the CPA organization as a caring and compassionate professional body. Some of the factors in establishing a bursary or scholarship that the Board may take into consideration are:

- a. A minimum of \$1,000 is paid annually for a term of five years
- b. CPA Alberta will provide administration for the bursary and scholarship funds and issue any tax receipts to the funds' contributors
- c. The funding of the bursary can come from a combination of the following:
 - Fully paid by CPA NWT/NU within the organization's financial means.
 - Sponsored Bursary or Scholarship fully funded by the sponsor will only be disbursed under the eligibility criteria specified by the sponsor.
 - Some combination of a fully paid and sponsored bursary and scholarship

CPA NWT/NU AWARDS
Eligibility Criteria

All applications for Awards must include a cover letter of 250 to 500 words or a 2 to 5-minute video detailing the eligibility criteria and the reasons why the applicant is the best candidate for the Award.
